

Darke County Special Olympics School-Age/SlammersBasketball 2017

Dear Players, Parents, and Providers

Your child is eligible and invited to participate in the Darke County Special Olympics program for the 2016-17 school year. We have activities that happen during the year and the basketball season is approaching. This is the 22nd year for Darke County Special Olympics to have a school-age team.

The Darke County Slammers basketball team consists of players (boys and girls) from all Darke County and Greenville City Schools. **All players must be between 13 and 21 years old to participate.** Players must be 13 years old by August 1, 2016.

Players are expected to attend all practices and games. This will be an average of two nights per week starting in January 2016. There is no cost to play on this team. A complete schedule of practices and games will be given at the first practice. Home and Away Games are played against other counties. Practices and Home Games will take place in Versailles (new Jr. High gym and old HS gym at the current school board office facility).

Those playing must have a current Special Olympics physical on file. A complete list of who will need a physical completed will be at the first meeting/practice.
